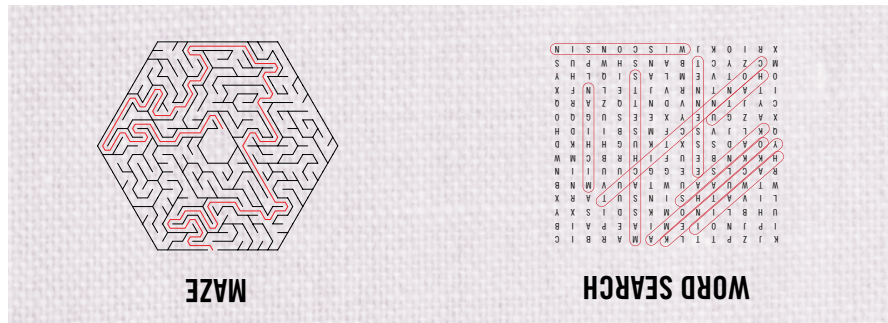
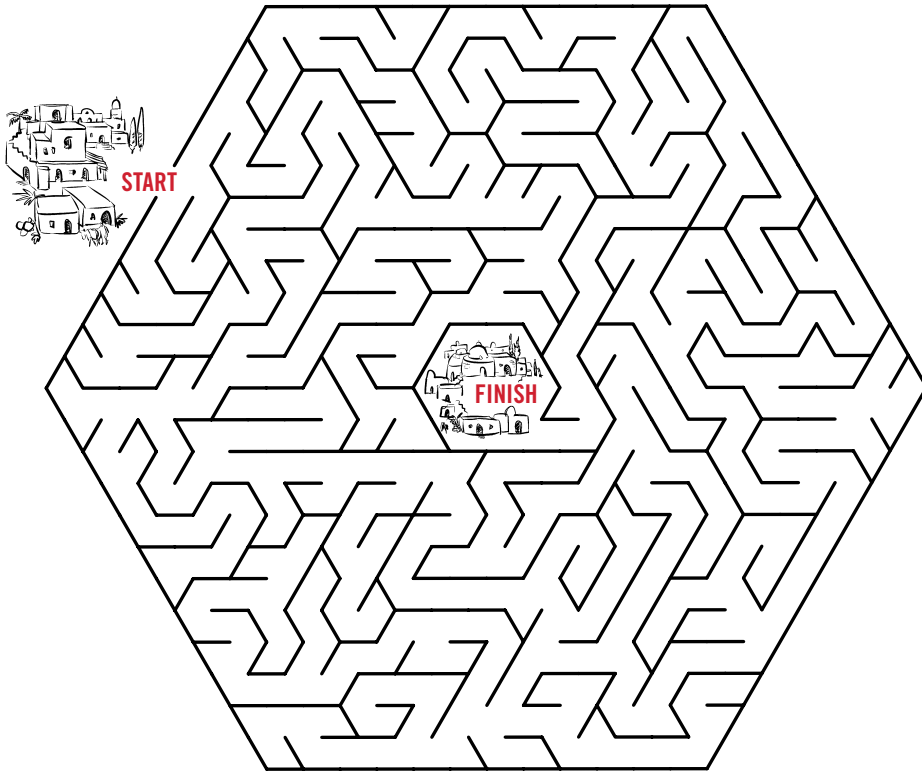


## MAZE

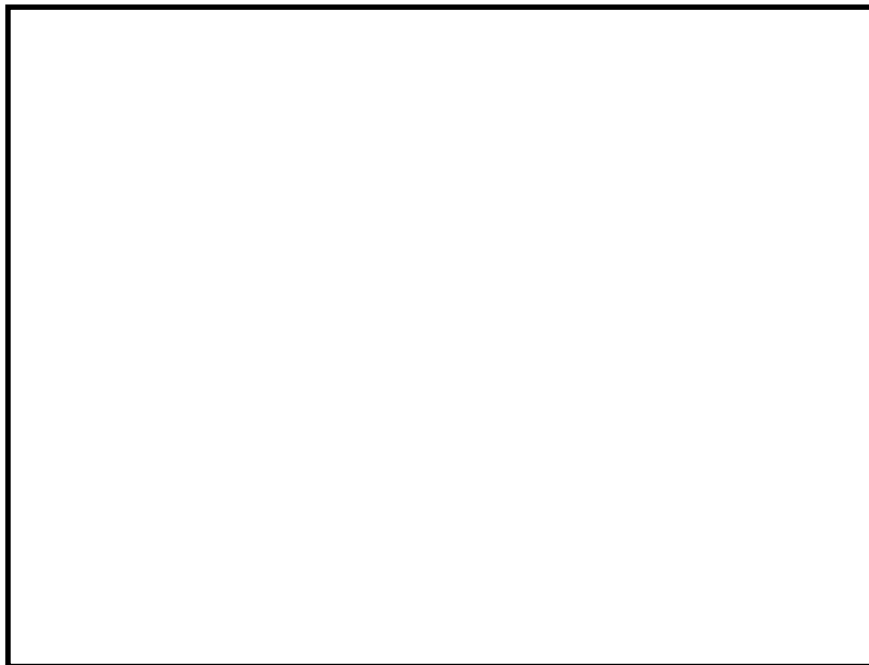
