May 9, 2021 A time to give thanks for the women who have

Before there was an official Mother's Day holiday in the US, Ann Jarvis, a Methodist mom, organized "Mothers' Friendship Day" in the late 1860's.

Pentecost May 23, 2021

We remember the day the disciples received the Holy Spirit in a special way as described in Acts 2. Over 3,000 people were baptized, creating the first church. This is why Pentecost is known as the birthday of the Christian church.

The word Pentecost comes from a Greek word meaning fiftieth. The Christian festival of Pentecost falls on the 50th day after the resurrection of Jesus.

Are you ready to celebrate Pentecost—the birth of the church? May 23 is Pentecost Sunday. This is when the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles and other disciples. Pentecost marks the beginning of the church and its mission to the world.


