Summer is here! Well, actually it starts on June 20, but that is this month. What an exciting time. Graduations are in full swing. As is our tradition at Trinity, we will be having Graduate Recognition Sunday on June 6 during worship. On the evening of June 3 we had an IAF (Industrial Areas Foundation) California Action to keep California families from being evicted from their homes. We had over 600 attendees at the Zoom meeting with multiple State legislators as guests. The State legislators were quite supportive of the need to help families that are close to eviction due to the pandemic. It is important that we now send this message to our State senators as they will vote in the next 10 days on this measure. Please see the **article "Action Alert "** in this June Trumpet that

explains how you can reach out to senators with this important message.

Two weeks ago it was announced by our District Superintendent Samuel Hong that I would be returning to Trinity next year. I am honored and it is a privilege to serve as pastor at Trinity UMC Sunnyvale. Also in that announcement was my appointment as pastor to First UMC Sunnyvale. Again, I am honored and it is a privilege to have the opportunity to serve as pastor at First UMC Sunnyvale. We will all let the Holy Spirit lead us into where God is calling our two churches this next year. There is much Kingdom building opportunity in Sunnyvale and the surrounding areas. If we keep our eyes focused on the mission of our churches, **"to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world", God will lead us** into unimaginable opportunities for mission in our community and world.

We have formed a task force that is meeting every

two weeks to plan the reopening of Trinity (and First Sunnyvale and Korean Methodist Church). In our first meeting (May 25) we made great progress in defining the appropriate protocols to ensure safety for all when we meet for in-person worship. We have yet to finalize a timeframe for reopening, but a reopening date is being evaluated. One of the stipulations for reopening is the capability to provide hybrid worship so that attendees that choose to continue with live stream worship can do so.

Lastly, I want to thank Rev. Clyde Vaughn for allowing my family to celebrate the graduations of our twin daughters in the months of May and June. Trinity is so blessed to have Clyde as a guest preacher when I am away on vacation.

**YOU WILL MAKE A DIFFERENCE**

At the Statewide IAF meeting on June 3, Trinity committed us to submitting a comment by June 15 regarding the need to EXTEND and EXPAND tenant protections by amending SB 91.

Our State Senators, Assembly Members, and Governor Newsom must hear from you now. The Senate and Assembly budget committees need to hear from you. Reach out to your representative at <http://findyourrep.legislature.ca.gov/>. Use the "Contact" button on the representative's website to link you to a contact form. "Select an Issue" such as COVID-19, Bill/ Legislation or that which relates closely to your comment. Identify yourself as a leader in the Silicon Valley Sponsoring Committee and a member of Trinity UMC Sunnyvale. Following are a few points for the contact form.

- When the eviction moratorium expires on June 30, over a million California families are at risk of homelessness, if the State does not act now to expand and extend protections for renters until the end of 2021.
- Amend SB 91 to expand eligibility and allow more flexibility in distribution. SB 91 only provides relief to tenants who owe back rent directly to their landlords. Many renters

borrowed from payday lenders, family, friends and others to keep their rent current, or sublease from others.

- In order for families to get back to work and repay their debts, tenants need the flexibility to use rental relief funds to prepay rent for at least six months.

- SB 91 must be expanded to include families who sublease.
