The program for the day was "Remember When - Memories of Trinity Over the Years!" Great memories were shared by Gloria C., Lois C., Chris C., Jane D., Melva I., Debbie S., Judy W.

Since Gloria C. is one of the original founding members of Trinity, we asked her to share first. Gloria told about going to downtown San Jose, where Trinity was to feed the homeless on the weekend. This event was held in a building whose owner was known to a Trinity member. Trinity volunteers brought the food and some remained for the night as supervisors, while the homeless slept indoors. Lois remembered that she and Scott brought the food one night.

Did you ever hear about the event called "The One Event Dress"? Lois showed the copy of the invitation to that event and also photos of Trinity women wearing their best "event dress"! This was a fund raiser for Pastor Sifa Setoki to pay for shipping supplies to Tonga.

Melva remembered Stewardship Dinners—the men barbecuing the steaks and everyone bringing other dishes for their tables! She remembered that wine was served with the dinners! (That was approved by Pastor Dick Bowman.)

Chris remembered the Rummage Sales! We shared memories of the Craft Faires,

Wednesday Night "TC" (this was Sunday School with a variety of options for the adults. Eventually dinner was included for the working families with Jane doing simple food!) Everyone talked about the Christmas Pageants (and two of the grandchildren were Baby Jesus); the Halloween Parties; the Lutheran Potlucks: Ice Cream Socials and the Big Bands led by Marvin B.; Christmas Eve services; Youth Volleyball; Friday Night Bowling; Super Bowl Alternative; modifying the building for the Rotating Shelter!—and then the talent shows!!!; New Years Eve gatherings.

There were so many memories that the person taking notes could not write it all down. Enjoy the memories you have and continue to make!
