JOIN US FOR SUNDAY WORSHIP In Person or On Zoom

It has been an eventful and blessed August at Trinity! Yes, we successfully reopened for in-person worship on August 1. Actually, it is more than that, as we re-opened with hybrid church! This means you can choose to go to worship, Sunday School, Youth Group, adult small groups, and other Trinity ministries by either attending in person or online over Zoom. This is an incredible accomplishment and many thanks go to Bob M. for leading this important ministry effort. We can even have Fellowship Time as a hybrid church-what a wonderful experience.

I must tell you that I had goose bumps when our scripture reader on August 8 was Bob C. reading from his home.
