Dear Trinity family and friends,

Happy September! Before I introduce our upcoming September ministries at Trinity, let's take a brief look back at August.

Can you believe we have now been a hybrid church for an entire month? Not only did we successfully reopen our in-person worship service, but also we continued an online option as well using Zoom. We further extended the hybrid access to Fellowship Time, children's Sunday school, Youth Group and Small Groups. Yes, we had a few technical glitches appear on a couple of Sundays, but they were minor and fixed by the following Sunday! Thank you to our terrific worship tech team for supporting this new hybrid service.

Now let's look at September. This upcoming Sunday, September 5, we will have "Coffee with Pastor Jay" during the Fellowship Time. At Fellowship Time, I will provide more detail about the progress of our merger between First Sunnyvale and Trinity Sunnyvale. The church leadership of both churches has agreed on the structure for the new merged church. Hallelujah and thanks be to God! Both churches have wonderful leadership, which made this process quite smooth and straightforward.

Beginning Sunday, September 12, we will begin a sermon series based upon the book Blueprint for Discipleship by author Kevin Watson, PhD, and professor at Emory University. Dr. Watson's book is based upon John Wesley's Three General Rules for Christian Living. The book will be available that Sunday for those that would like to follow along reading with the sermon series. Reading the book is absolutely not a prerequisite for the sermon series; I just make it available for those that would like to dive further into the subject. We

suggest a \$15 donation if you would like a book, but that is also not requirement. If you are recognizing the name of the book and think we might already done a have sermon series on it, you are correct. In my first year at Trinity, we did a sermon series on the book. I think you will find this to not only be a good review of Wesley's General Rules, but also we will see the progress Trinity has made in discipleship and begin to map out the next steps.
